

### Introduction

Carle Place Union Free School District (UFSD) was established in 1915 and serves all of Carle Place and parts of Westbury and Mineola, in central Nassau County, NY. The school district consists of 3 public schools, about 1,450 students, 151 teachers, and 221 staff members.

# Challenge

After a past natural disaster left the UFSD operations struggling to conduct normal business (i.e., paying bills and salaries) and relying on generator power with limited access to facilities for over a week, the district decided to update its Disaster Recovery plan and solution.

The USFD wanted a solution that would allow replication to the Cloud so that business operations could continue in the event of a disaster. The UFSD needed to find an IT service provider that:
